

The Spoetzl Brewery is thrilled to welcome everyone back to the annual GASP bike ride on October 16th. Whether you are riding, cheering for your family and friends, or just coming out to enjoy some ice-cold Shiner beer, our top priority is everyone's safety. With that, the Spoetzl Brewery has decided to implement the following policies on race day.

- Riders will not be required to wear a face covering while out on the course.
 - We will continue to stagger the start times at 7am (100 mile) 9 am (50 mile) and 10 am (25 mile). We ask that you try and keep 6 ft of distance between yourself and other riders during the line-up. If this is not possible, please wear your mask before the ride begins.
- All attendees will not be required to wear a face covering when seated in their group. Please remain with your group as best as possible throughout the day.
- All attendees, ages 5 and up, will be required to wear a face covering when walking around the event and standing in beer*, food, or restroom lines. *Beer will only be served to individuals aged 21+.
- All attendees, ages 5 and up, will be required to wear a face covering when in any brewery building, including the giftshop or while taking a tour.
- All tours will be limited to a 20-person maximum. Please sign up for tours in the giftshop.

Within the 14 days leading up to the ride, if any of the following apply, please stay home. You will be able to roll over your registration to the 2022 ride.

1. If you have tested positive or begin to experience symptoms of COVID-19.
2. You have knowingly come in contact with a confirmed, or suspected, positive individual.

Please bring your own mask, but if you forget, we will have a limited supply available at our info booth. We will have hand sanitizers on site and encourage everyone to bring their own as well.
